



Drive-in Requirements

The following guidelines are provided to ensure the safest possible outdoor experience in a COVID-19 environment.

AHS Guidelines

- We encourage attendees (RNA Volunteers) are to adhere to all public AHS guidelines. Be prepared to answer basic questions upon entry related to COVID-19 possible exposure.
- All attendants are equipped with appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to carry out their tasks.

Park & Exit

- Proof of ticket purchase will be required at the main gate.
- Parking attendants will direct vehicles to parking stalls.
- All vehicles must exit the parking lot through the SW corner of the lot. (Vehicles will be directed by attendees.)

Washrooms

- Washrooms are available on the East side of the parking lot. (Beside the Football Field Locker Rooms)
- If a trip to the washroom is unavoidable, please wear a face mask when outside your vehicle.
- A wash station equipped with hand sanitizer is available at the location.

Vehicle Restrictions

- Attendees must avoid leaving their vehicles for the entire duration of the event.
- No attendees may sit outside of, or on, their vehicles.
- Windows may be opened half-way only if vehicles are two metres apart.
- Vehicle doors must remain closed.
- Attendees cannot move between vehicles during the movie.
- The maximum number of occupants for each vehicle must not be greater than the number of vehicle seats.

Problems?

- Headlights are to remain off during the movie. If a vehicle must be started during the event the running lights may be turned off by engaging the parking brake or a shut off button on the light switch. Failing that, a blanket or jacket over the lights may be necessary.
- Dead batteries can result from using accessories for an extended period. A booster pack will be onsite should the need for a boost arise. Please stay in your car until all others have left. A team will be on site to help once the traffic has settled down.
